## **Impromptu**

**Description**: The competitor is given two (2) minutes to prepare a speech on a randomly drawn quotation or topic.

**Goal**: To create a polished speaker who is able to give an original, spontaneously prepared speech within the room, using the selected topic as the central theme.

## **Impromptu Preparation Rules:**

1. Topics should be of the same type for all speakers in the round (e.g. all quotations or all abstract concepts, etc.)

## **Impromptu Administration Rules:**

- 1. One judge in each room will be given room administration instructions, including topic distribution.
- 2. A list of possible topics will be given to each of the other judges in the room.
- 3. In the room, a competitor will draw three (3) single topics, choose one (1), and return the other two (2) topics before leaving the room. The chosen topic should not be returned.
- 4. Preparation time begins as soon as the competitor draws the first topic.
- 5. During preparation time, timepiece must be **facing toward the competitor** and **counting down**. Local tournaments may still choose to give verbal countdown signals every thirty (30) seconds until two (2) minutes have elapsed.
- 6. The speaker may write notes on a blank sheet of paper during preparation time, but he may not use or refer to the notes during his speech.
- 7. Unused preparation time may not be added to the speaking time.

## **Impromptu Presentation Rules:**

- 1. The speaker may approach the topic in any way he chooses, but the topic must be the central theme of the speech and not peripheral to it.
- 2. The speaker may not bring any prepared material into the room.
- 3. During the speech, the competitor may only the chosen topic slip.
- 4. The speaker must state his topic early in the speech and adhere to the chosen topic.
- 5. Each speech should be a fresh, original presentation, developed from one of the topics given and prepared on the spot.
- 6. No computers, Kindles, iPods, cell phones, or other electronic media devices may be used for Impromptu preparation or presentation.
- 7. No audio or visual aids or props may be used.
- 8. Gratuitous vulgarity is strictly prohibited.
- 9. The student must not listen to other Impromptu competitors speaking before him. He may stay after he has given his speech to listen to subsequent speakers
- 10. Competitors must not listen to other Impromptu competitors speaking before them.
- 11. Maximum speaking time is five (5) minutes.
- 12. Competitors will receive a one (1) rank penalty for going over time by fifteen (15) seconds or more.

Preparation time – two (2) minutes. Speaking time – five (5) minutes. No minimum time.
